6. Par beach Footpaths – It was agreed that to ask the clerk to ask council officer to attend a parish council meeting soon to let the whole council know how this would be progressed. If necessary Councillor Johnston will assist by gathering more evidence from the people who have walked the paths longest. It is apparently very important that any application is specific for it to have any chance of success.

7. Allotments – Cllr Hughes was asked to assemble the detail we need from the council on how to progress this. (Costs and numbers of people on the waiting list). Councillor Wildish is meeting with Groundwork to get some help on taking forward the proposed new allotments at Poldrea.

8. Flood plan – Charles Richards updated the meeting on what has been going on with the Flood plan and wardens. Confirmation has been received from EA that we need to arrange our own insurance, Charles is happy to make the arrangements but would like councils to pay half each. Councillor wildish asked him to check if this would cover wardens to act as Community Emergency wardens too as it would be a burden on the council to pay two lots of insurance. If this is the case Cllr Johnston would like a resolution to the next meeting that the council should contribute 50% to the cost of the insurance.
