

St Blazey Area Network meeting 1st Aug at Tywardreath Village Hall

I could not attend meeting so report taken from official notes taken at the time by Lisa Grigg

Jim Johnston as a member of the public handed in a **Par Beach Footpath petition**. It had been brought before the Network Meeting as it met the County threshold of 1 % of the total population of the network area. a total of 196 signatures being on the petition. M E confirmed that our parish clerk had received the preliminary documents for making an application under the modification order so it was agreed that the issue should be handed back to Tywardreath & Par Parish Council as we are the appropriate lead body

M E was asked to obtain figures from April 09 (start of unitary authority) until present of number of decisions made by the council contrary to parish and town views.

David Hughes referred to the Planning Procedure Panel with regard to decision making arrangements Between Councillors and officers of Town and Parish Councils i.e how we respond to planning applications. More planning training is to be arranged.

Robin Miller, Community Intelligence Lead leads a team who provide a statistical over view of each network area he explained why this collected information was useful at local level He will return with data for our area at the Dec meeting. It will cover information about population, economic environmental and social circumstances He will circulate information in advance of the meeting in relation to the flood plain areas David asked if the intelligence team could help with questionnaires for part of parish plans. This was welcomed by Robin Miller
