Blue Green Event - StARR Project Good News!

In April we were delighted to have a stand at the PL24 Futures where all the talk was about how we could make this area a better place to live by dealing with the risk of flooding through the St Austell Resilient Regeneration Project (StARR). This was followed by our own Blue Green Event in July when Parish based local groups, organisations, churches and others including the Environment Agency, Ocean Housing and Eden on Prescription listened to a presentation on the research into Blue Green Healthcare. Follow up activities led to lively exchanges of ideas and lots of positive suggestions as to how we could make it easier for everyone to access Blue Green Spaces like Par Canal, Tywardreath Marshes, St Andrew's Road Pond and Local Nature Reserve (the duck pond), the sea, the beach, the countryside, community gardens, footpaths and bridleways. And it is really good news that the StARR project's bid for funding has been successful, so watch this space!
