What is a Community Land Trust?

A not for profit, community based organisation run by volunteers that develops housing at permanently affordable levels, or other assets, for long term community benefit

The statutory definition is in Part 2 of the Housing and Regeneration Act 2008





Cornwall Community Land Trust

Community Benefit Society with charitable rules established as an umbrella CLT for Cornwall in 2007

Help local communities set up their own community land trust

Develop community-led affordable housing

Work closely with **communities and Parish/Town Councils** to develop affordable housing and other assets for local people





Cornwall CLT housing ambitions

1. Standard – Helping communities & changing family life for the better

Community Led – local CLT or Housing Working Party led.

Homes "for Locals Forever" – for 'locals' & in perpetuity.

Homes that provide low cost living – affordable to run - maximise energy efficiency.

Decent homes - good space standards - > nationally described space standards.

Genuinely affordable - less than two thirds of open market value & 'affordable' rent.

Working with nature – Cornwall Wildlife Trust partner. Work to mitigate impact.

2. Scale

From 20+ to **50 + new homes** each year by 2022

Cornwall CLT Achievements

Has developed or helped to deliver 236 homes since 2007

3 schemes recently completed (Landrake, St Teath & Rame 29 homes),

1 (Duloe 18 homes) due to complete next month; another to start later this year at Ruan Minor (6 homes)

6 potential pipeline developments (76+ homes by end 2020)

Cornwall Community Land Trust and local CLTs have delivered a **significant percentage** of the national CLT output – 241 of 800








