Setting Up

- We set up a Steering Group and 5 Focus Groups: Housing and Planning; Business and Employment; Environment, Heritage; Health and Wellbeing and Community Engagement. In Autumn 2017, lots of people filled in an initial survey and gave us lots of ideas. We were out and about at community events e.g. The Big Lunch.
- We are all volunteers and we would welcome more Focus Group members.

Consultation

- This is where we are now in Spring 2018.
- Kernow Youth is talking with Young Adults and we are running 2 surveys: Business, and Housing Need. There is a Health and Wellbeing Workshop for organisers from local groups; and a large Community event in September. We also have an Environment and Heritage recording project. Get in touch if you want to help!

Draft the Plan

- The Neighbourhood Plan sets out the aims and vision for land use and development in the Parish. It reflects the views of the community and captures what is important to local people. It is based upon the findings from surveys, community consultation events and the final questionnaire which will go out during Winter 2018.
- We will consult on the draft plan in Spring 2019.

Review & Finalise the Plan

- The Neighbourhood Plan sets out our policies, adding detail to the guidance in the Cornwall Local Plan. We hope to do this by Summer 2019.
- We need to consider whether we (re)-instate Settlement Boundaries.
- Cornwall Council Development Officers will advise us on whether we need to do a Sustainability, Strategic, Environmental Assessment (SSEA).

Independent Inspection

- The Neighbourhood Plan is nearly finished, so it is time for feedback from national groups like English Heritage and The Environment Agency.
- The Plan is amended in the light of feedback and the Parish Council signs off on it.
- The Plan is independently inspected this will take up to 5 months.

Referendum

- Our community, Our future, Our Plan You decide!
- Everyone on the electoral roll will be able to vote on whether to adopt the Plan, in late Spring or Summer 2020.
