

## Setting Up

- **We set up a Steering Group and 5 Focus Groups:** Housing and Planning ; Business and Employment; Environment, Heritage; Health and Wellbeing and Community Engagement. In Autumn 2017, we did an Initial Survey and lots of people gave us lots of ideas. We were out and about at community events e.g. The Big Lunch.
- **We are all volunteers and we would welcome more Focus Group members.**

## Consultation

- Between April and November 2018 Kernow Youth ran a Young Adult Consultation and we organised 2 surveys: Business and Employers and Housing Need. The Blue Green Health and Wellbeing Workshop for local groups and organisations was a huge success and we took the opportunity to gather views on Blue Green Tourism too. We also made a start on compiling evidence for Environment and Heritage.

## Draft the Plan

- **The Neighbourhood Plan** sets out the aims and vision for land use and development in the Parish. It reflects the views of the community, captures what is important to local people and is based on evidence e.g. what people tell us at events and in the surveys. For example, respondents to the Residents' Questionnaire (Jan 2019) told us they support a settlement boundary around Par and Tywardreath.

## Review & Finalise the Plan

- **The Draft Neighbourhood Plan sets out our policies**, adding detail to the guidance in the Cornwall Local Plan. We hope to have a first rough draft by winter 2019.
- Cornwall Council Development Officers will comment on the draft and advise us on whether we need to do a Sustainability, Strategic, Environmental Assessment (SSEA).

## Independent Inspection

- **The Draft Neighbourhood Plan** will go out for comment to national groups like English Heritage, the Environment Agency; and the community sometime in 2020.
- The Plan is amended in the light of feedback and the Parish Council signs off on it.
- The Plan is independently inspected - this will take up to 5 months.

## Referendum

- **Our community, Our future, Our Plan - You decide !**
- Everyone on the electoral roll will be able to vote on whether to adopt the Plan.
- We are hoping that the referendum will take place in late Spring or Summer 2020.
