

What does 'medium' mean?

The government has announced a three-tiered approach to classifying coronavirus restrictions in England.

So what does this mean for Cornwall?

Meeting friends and family - You can meet in groups of up to six people from multiple households. This applies indoors and outdoors.

Going out - All pubs, bars and restaurants must close at 10pm and are restricted to table service only.

Face coverings - Face coverings must be worn on public transport and in enclosed areas, such as shops, museums and cinemas.

You can be fined £200 for breaking the rules.

Working - You should work from home if possible. Talk to your employer about your situation.

If you can't work from home, your employer should ensure your working environment complies with the Covid safe working guidelines.
