#### **13/211 Application for an Entertainment/Alcohol Licence, Par Beach**

It was suggested that a Licence for music (albeit background music) could be intrusive to the local Nature Reserve and also that a Licence for alcohol would be at variance with the covenant signed by Tywardreath & Par parish council on 26<sup>th</sup> March 1914. After further discussion Cllr Phillips proposed, Cllr Taylor seconded that the alcohol licence should be restricted to a table licence. An amendment was proposed by Cllr Johnston, seconded Cllr Wildish that there should be no alcohol licence of any kind on the site in line with the 1914 covenant. Voting on the amendment was 2 in favour 5 against. Voting on the original proposal was 5 in favour, 2 against. It was, therefore, RESOLVED that the parish

council should object to the application on the basis that the alcohol licence should be restricted to a table licence only.
