- Concern about privacy and overlooking to 60, 61, 62, 64 and 2, Polmear Parc, including their amenity space and bedrooms.
- Impact on residential amenities with construction traffic; the area was already experiencing severe street parking problems
- The design of the proposed extension, due to its size and scaling was inappropriate

2. PA16/10152. Increase single storey dwelling into a two storey dwelling. 33, Polmear Road, Par. Cllr Scrafton was asked to investigate the lack of public notification of this application. It was proposed by Cllr Phillips, seconded Cllr Brasier and RESOLVED that a recommendation of objection should be made to Cornwall Council. Reason: 1. Unacceptable impact on privacy and overlooking issues to 60, 61, 62, 64 and 2, Polmear Parc, including their amenity spaces and bedrooms. 2. The design of the proposed extension, due to its size and scaling is incongruous in the streetscene and is out of character with the integrity of neighbouring properties
